She especially loved going to Lancaster, PA to see the plays at Sight and Sound Theater. She loved Jesus and enjoyed reading books by the late Rev. Billy Graham and other Christian authors. She was a member of the Woodstock Christian Church, a faithful servant of God here on earth and was always trying to help others in any way she could.
