



## Burdette Foltz

August 20, 1930 - March 28, 2017

Burdette Foltz, 86, of Edinburg, passed away Tuesday, March 28, 2017 at Consulate Health Care in Woodstock, Virginia. The funeral service will be held Friday, March 31 at 11:00 a.m. at Valley Funeral Service in Bowman's Crossing. Reverend Matthew Diehl and Mr. Nelson Swope will officiate. Burial will follow in Isaiah Clem Cemetery in Fort Valley. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service.

Mr. Foltz was born August 20, 1930 in Bowman's Crossing, son of the late Alton Carroll and Mary Irene Pence Foltz. He was a 1950 graduate of Edinburg High School and an army veteran of the Korean Conflict. He was a prominent auctioneer and co-owner of Foltz Inc. and a farmer. He was formerly employed with Safeway, a truck driver for many different freight companies and a deputy sheriff in Shenandoah County. He was a member of Mt. Calvary Lutheran Church in Mt. Jackson and the Woodstock American Legion Post #199 and Edinburg VFW Post #2447.

He is survived by his wife, Meta Walter Foltz whom he married on November 3, 1957; two sons, G.B. Foltz and wife Susan of Edinburg, and Joe Foltz and wife Mary Beth of Edinburg; one sister, Peggy Keller of Toms Brook; three step brothers, Larry, Nelson and Gene Keller; four grandchildren, Emily Virginia Foltz, Adam Burdette Foltz, Johnathan Walter Foltz, and Joseph Martin Foltz.
