



Calvin Franklin Swartz

May 25, 1935 - July 6, 2017

Calvin Franklin Swartz, 82, of Edinburg Virginia passed away on July 6, 2017 at his home surrounded by family.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, July 10th at 11:00 a.m. at Mt Zion Lutheran Church in Woodstock, Virginia with Pastor Anna Havron officiating. Burial will follow at Sunset View Memorial Gardens with military honors by the Woodstock American Legion Post #199.

Calvin was born May 25, 1935 in Saumsville, a son of the late Noah Franklin Swartz and Fannie Gochenour Swartz.

He was a life time member and also served as Trustee for many years at Mt Zion Lutheran Church of Woodstock, Virginia. He served in the United States Air Force during the Korean War.

He was a member of the American Legion Post #199 Woodstock, former President of the St Luke Fairview Ruritan Club and a member of the Edinburg Shell Station Liars Club.

He retired from Shenandoah Mutual Fire Insurance Company in 2000 after 31 years of service, having served as Claims Adjuster, Secretary, and Chairman of the Board. He stepped down on March 1, 2015 due to poor health. He was the President of Swartz's Tractor Service, Inc.

Calvin was preceded in death by three brothers, Harold Swartz, Ralph Swartz

and Jack Swartz; and one sister, Mary Alice Foltz.

He married Katrena Funkhouser Swartz on May 25, 1960.
