Carl Nelson, 93, of Edinburg, VA passed away Tuesday, February 14, 2023, at Shenandoah Memorial Hospital. A memorial service will be held Saturday, February 18, 2023, at 2:00pm at the Woodstock Presbyterian Church. Rev. Joan Wilson and Rev. Dennis Burnett will officiate.

Mr. Nelson was born July 11, 1929, in New Jersey, and was a first generation American as his parents, Astrid and Carl A. Nelson were immigrants from Sweden. Carl was a 1948 graduate of Grover Cleveland High School in Caldwell, New Jersey and served in the Army from 1951-1953 in Panama. He grew up in West Caldwell, New Jersey and retired to Virginia in 1990. He was a manager for Acme Markets for over 36 years. Along with his parents, he is preceded in death by his sisters, Edna and Margaret; and a niece, Holly Greenwood.

He is survived by his wife of 61 years, Alison Scott Nelson; children, Carla Nelson, James Nelson, and Trina Ouzts (Steve); and his grandchildren, Alan Schultes, Brian Schultes, Kristen Ouzts, and Anna Schultes.

Carl believed in using his time and talent in helping others. He did this by doing numerous jobs at the Bread of Life Food Pantry and belonging to the Woodstock Lion's Club, whose main focus is to help those underserved individuals who have sight and hearing problems. He also loved working in the
