



## Carol Ann Coleman

August 3, 1939 - March 31, 2018

Carol Ann Coleman, 78, of Woodstock, Virginia, passed in the early morning of March 31, 2018 at her home with family members by her side. She was born in Huntington, West Virginia August 3, 1939. Her parents were Edgar and Sylvia Coffman. Both were called home early in Carol's life and she was raised by her paternal grandmother, Lillian Coffman until Carol's graduation from Huntington High School in 1957. Her paternal lineage was from Allegany County, Virginia and Greenbrier County, West Virginia. Her maternal lineage was from McDowell County, West Virginia and Tazewell County, Virginia. Her husband of 57 years, John Coleman, survives. They were married in Huntington in March of 1961. They have four sons, James Coleman (Catherine) of Lexington, Virginia, Walter Coleman (Valerie) of Midlothian, Virginia, John Coleman of Forest, Virginia and David Coleman of Tenth Legion, Virginia. All the sons were born in Kalispell, Montana. There are 10 grandchildren. Carol followed John's 37 year career in the U.S. Forest Service.

In the early years of marriage she stayed at home with her young family. The family lived in five states on eight U.S. Forest Service Ranger Districts. She began working again in 1977 in Stanton, Virginia as a legal secretary. After moving to Woodstock in 1979, she worked for First Virginia Bank until her retirement. She was an active member of the Woodstock Presbyterian Church where she was a long time treasurer of the Women of the Church and a member of the choir. She was a dedicated supporter of her sons' sports

activity while in high school and college. She loved and cherished her grandchildren and enjoyed visiting them and following their sports activities. She was a great listener and friend to many people including many teenagers during her son's high school time. A memorial celebration service will be held in the Woodstock Presbyterian Church April 7 at 11 a.m. followed by a fellowship luncheon in the Fellowship Hall. She passed following a long siege with pulmonary hypertension and COPD.
