Carroll Henry "Bud" Wilkin, 89, of Woodstock went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, October 17, 2021, at Winchester Medical Center.

Bud was born September 15, 1932, in Maurertown, Virginia, son of the late George W. Wilkin, Sr. and Georgie Carr Wilkin. He was predeceased by his brothers, James Wilkin and George W. Wilkin, Jr.
