It is with sadness that we announce the passing of Charles Benjamin "Ben" Sisler, 95, formerly of Falls Church and New Market, VA. He passed away peacefully on February 24, 2022 at Shenandoah Memorial Hospital, Woodstock, VA.

Mr. Sisler was an active businessman and President of Sislers Stone Incorporated, a family-owned masonry/hardscape business. He was a member of the Virginia State Fire Chief's Association, the American Legion Post 166, and Fraternal Order of the Eagles Post #4264.

Mr. Sisler was a World War II naval veteran, having served as a gunner's mate aboard the USS Intrepid CV-11.

Ben was a life member and served 74 years in the Falls Church Volunteer Fire Department. He served as Fire Chief for 15 years.

He is survived by his wife Mary of 64 years, four children Nelson (NC), Donald (FL), Kathy (NC), and Stephen (VA); several grandchildren and greatgrandchildren; and nieces and nephews.
