Cletus Rodney Lindamood Jr., 91, of Edinburg passed away on Thursday, March 5, 2020, at his home surrounded by his family. The funeral service will be held Monday, March 9, at 3:00 p.m. at Pleasant View Church of the Brethren. Pastors Jack Tucker and Doug Gochenour will officiate. Burial will follow in the church cemetery.

Cletus was born August 22, 1928, in Mount Jackson, Virginia, the son of the late Cletus Rodney Lindamood Sr. and Bertha Ellen Collins Lindamood. He was a graduate of Triplett High School class of 1947 and an army veteran. He formerly worked at Bowman Brothers, the Edinburg Mill, and retired from VDOT Toms Brook Headquarters in 1993.
