David Alan Williams, 74, of Edinburg, passed away on Sunday, February 23, 2025, at Shenandoah Memorial Hospital, where he suffered a fatal heart attack.

David was born on June 25, 1950, in Arlington, Virginia and was the son of the late Chester and Patricia Farr Williams. His brother Donald also predeceased him.

Dave grew up in Falls Church, Virginia and attended Marshall High School where he played football and participated in track and field. Upon graduation, he attended Wofford Collage in Spartanburg, South Carolina where he played football on a scholarship. After graduation from Wofford, he returned to Northern Virginia and went to work for Fairfax County government as an appraiser. After a 30 year career in real estate assessments, he retired in 2001, and relocated to the Shenandoah Valley where he had spent a good part of his youth and adult life on weekends. Dave's hobbies included traveling, particularly to Spain and Cancun, and around the states. He was an avid enthusiast of both motorcycles and bicycles and spent many a weekend at race events, participating in mountain bike and motocross races. After retirement, he enjoyed more traveling and real estate and property management with his family partnership. Although he was no longer racing, he devoted more time to bicycling, including 2 cross country bike trips, as well

as riding scooters on multiple trips around the country, and riding his favorite motorcycles, especially on back roads.

Lastly and most importantly, he enjoyed spending time with his many friends and family. Those who knew Dave all were struck by his generous nature. He was always willing to help and was always one to count on. He truly had a big heart. He was loved by many and will be sorely missed.

David leaves behind his long time partner, Janice Fleming, her sons Joshua, Daniel (Lindsay), Christopher (Trista), Scott (Jennifer) and her grandchildren, and his brother, Hampton Williams, his wife, Sue, their daughter Susan (Andrew), and nieces and nephews, Trish, Chet (Erin), Josh (Annalise), Andrew (Fontina), Matthew (Jodi) and many grand nieces and nephews.
