Donald 'Don' Burnshire Clem, born April 1, 1933, passed peacefully at his home at the age of 86. He was a Member of Woodstock Christian Church, the American Legion and the Veterans of Foreign Wars. Donald was predeceased by his loving wife of 46 years, Doris Irene (Linaweaver) Clem, and their son, Charles W. Clem. Surviving are a daughter, Brenda McIntyre; a grandson, Joshua Davis Seal; and two great-grandchildren, Tristan Garrett Seal, who attends NC State on a full NROTC scholarship, and Brycon Davis Burnshire Seal. Mr. Clem served 4 years in the United States Marine Corps. He attributes his time in the military for teaching him the proper way to live. Mr. Clem served his country until 1957 and left the Marine Corps as a Staff Sergeant (E6). He worked 4 years for Shenandoah Telephone Company (Shentel) from 1957-1961. Mr. Clem then spent the next 29 years working for Old Southern Railroad (Norfolk Southern) and retired as Captain of their police department. After retirement, Donald enjoyed his life on a small farm at Burnshire Dam which was his pride and joy.
