Dorothy Ann Lambert 87 of Woodstock passed away on October 30, 2017. Dorothy was born on August 6, 1930 in Woodstock, Virginia the daughter of the late Ralph J. Lambert and Emma Funkhouser Lambert. She graduated from Woodstock High School in 1947 and Shenandoah Business School in 1948. Dorothy worked for Farmer's Mutual Telephone Co., the Town of Woodstock for 23 years serving as treasurer and clerk of the council, served as deputy clerk for the Shenandoah County Circuit Court for 12 years; and was a part-time bookkeeper for R.J. Lambert Moving and Storage. She was a lifelong member of St. Paul's United Church of Christ in Woodstock where she taught Sunday school, was financial secretary, treasurer, choir member, trustee, member of various committees and part time secretary. She volunteered at the Woodstock Library, the Blood Mobile, and the Woodstock Clothes Closet. Dorothy was preceded in death by brothers, Gordon, John, and Howard Lambert, sisters, Becky Lambert, and Peggy Hollar.
