Edward Charles Trelawny, 60, of Woodstock, passed away Saturday, August 11, 2018, at Winchester Medical Center. A Celebration of Life will be held Thursday, August 16 at 4:00 p.m. at Valley Funeral Service, 14116 S. Middle Road, Edinburg.

Mr. Trelawny was born November 17, 1957, in Doylestown, PA, son of Dr. Gilbert Sterling Trelawny of Harrisonburg and the late Florence Mulholland Trelawny.
