



## Elmer Clayton Jenkins

Mr. Elmer ""Brownie"" Clayton Jenkins died at the Virginia Hospital Center in Arlington, VA on August 7, 2010, at the age of 87. He was born in Mt. Jackson on November 23, 1922.
