George Robert Grandstaff, 78, lifelong resident of Edinburg passed away Tuesday at his home. The funeral will be held Friday, April 6th at 4:00 p.m. at St. Paul's United Church of Christ in Edinburg. Reverend John F. Taylor Jr. will officiate. Burial will follow in Cedarwood Cemetery in Edinburg. George was born July 9, 1933 in Shenandoah County, son of the late Hugh Oceola and Daisy Virginia Funkhouser Grandstaff. He was a supporter of Boy's Town, Humane Society, Sheriff's Department and many Indian reservations. George is survived by his brother, Hugh O.
