James Allen "Jimmy" Carter, 73, of Woodstock, passed away Sunday, September 30, 2018, at Blue Ridge Hospice in Winchester. No services are planned, and burial will be private. However, the family will receive friends at the Carter home, 342 Logan Circle in Woodstock, Thursday from 5-7 p.m. Mr. Carter was born August 1, 1945, in Woodstock, Virginia, son of the late George Robert Carter Sr. and Anna LaRue McKelvey Carter.
