James Richard "Rick" Looman, 72, of Edinburg, passed away Monday, May 11, 2026 at UVA Medical Center in Charlottesville. The funeral service will be held Saturday, May 16 at 11:00 a.m. at Wakemans Grove Church of the Brethren in Edinburg. Pastor C. Todd Crowder will officiate. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. The family will receive friends from 10-11 at the church.

Mr. Looman was born August 29, 1953 at home in Sunshine, WV., son of the late Everett James Looman and Ethel Elizabeth Smith Looman. He was a 1971 graduate of Stonewall Jackson High School. In his early adult years he drove heavy equipment in Northern Virginia and Bryce. He became an agent with Virginia Farm Bureau Insurance for 35 years and Pastor of Salem Church of the Brethren in Stephens City for 14 years. Before becoming a pastor, he was very active at Wakemans Grove Church of the Brethren, holding many positions including Sunday School teacher, Board Chairman and Deacon. He was also moderator for numerous churches in the Shenandoah District as well as lay speaker prior to pastoring at Salem Church of the Brethren.

Rick is survived by the love of his life of 51 years, Catherine Maude Stephens Looman whom he married on July 1, 1975; daughters, Jennifer Michelle
