Jayne Worsley Foltz passed on to meet her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ and join her mother Mary Ann Worsley on the streets of gold on Wednesday, January 27, 2021. Jayne was born in an apartment above the New York Restaurant that used to be located on South Main Street in Woodstock (across from where Walton and Smoot Pharmacy was, where the Shenandoah County Court House stands now). She lived her younger years in Toms Brook where she graduated from Toms Brook High School in 1946. She also taught one year at the Toms Brook School. Jayne moved to Arlington where she lived with her aunt and uncle, Kathrine and Cecil Smith. While living in Arlington, she began work with Hecht's Department Stores in 1949. Jayne was dedicated to Hecht's working in various different company stores in the Washington, DC, Virginia, and Maryland. She retired from Hecht's in (May's Co) in 1979. After retirement, Jayne moved to Edinburg and married Randolph H. Foltz. She was a devoted wife to Randolph as she sought to be a Proverbs 31 wife to him. Jayne was always grateful to Dorothy Rothgeb for doing in home Bible Study at the Foltz home. This led Jayne to a relationship forming with Ivor and Anna Lee Crisman as spiritual brother and sister that brought her to Valley Baptist Church. Jayne joined Valley Baptist Church in 1982 that she faithfully and actively attended as long as she could. Alzheimer Disease eventually prevented her further attendance and involvement with the church. Jayne is survived by her husband, Randolph H. Foltz; her sisters, Phyllis Fravel of Richmond and Patricia Van DeGriek of Sterling; she is also

survived by two nephews, a niece, and a great nephew, Corin that she loved very much and prayed for daily. Jayne was preceded in death by her parents, aunt and uncle, also a nephew, Kirby Van DeGrieck, that she missed very much as she devoted to pray for him daily prior to his untimely passing. Jayne will be greatly missed by her husband, Randolph, as she went to great lengths to care for him, even in her final state of dementia. She would say, she still loved him.
