Jeanne Parsons Edmunds passed away peacefully on December 9, 2022, in Woodstock, VA, after a long illness. She was preceded in death by her loving husband of 61 years, Stephen Orrell Edmunds, and is survived by her daughter Joan Zimmerman (Jess Diaz) of Fresno, CA; daughter Margaret Edmunds (Charles Fulwood) of Silver Spring, MD; and son Robert Edmunds (Carolyn) of Conway, SC; nephews Arthur B. Crow (Sylvia), Scott Brown, Donn Brown (Susan), and Gordon Hoover; grandchildren John Herndon (Paige), Jan Navarro, Laura Wicks, and Holly Link (Marty); and seven great grandchildren. Jeanne was born in Oak Creek, CO, on May 26, 1926; graduated from Oceana High School in Virginia Beach, VA; and attended the Norfolk VA branch of William and Mary (now Old Dominion University). After World War II she moved to Washington, DC and joined Calvary Baptist Church, where she met her husband Steve, played the piano at many church events, and served in a variety of church and Sunday School leadership roles. In the mid 1950s, Jeanne appeared on local television as a member of the A Cappella singing group the Chansonettes, and also was a frequent soloist for Calvary events. Jeanne served as Church Secretary for Glencarlyn Road Baptist Church in Falls Church, taught piano, and served as a Girl Scout troop leader and trainer for the Girl Scouts for 30 years before she and Steve retired

to Edinburg, VA in 1994. Jeanne was an active member of First Baptist Church of Woodstock for several years and taught dozens of people in the Shenandoah Valley how to quilt. She will be remembered for her cheerful smile, brightly colored clothing, and frequently asking "is there anything I can do for you?" A graveside service will be held at Cedarwood (Edinburg) Cemetery, 14993 Old Valley Pike, Edinburg VA at 1 pm on Tuesday, December 13th.
