Jerry Wayne "Meatball" Hines, 78, of Mount Jackson, passed away Sunday, October 24, 2021, at Winchester Medical Center. The family will receive friends Saturday from 6-8 p.m. at the funeral home.

Mr. Hines was born August 17, 1943, in Shenandoah County, son of the late Raymond Lee Hines and Tracie Hiser Hines Jones. He was a 1961 graduate of Stonewall Jackson High School, attended Dunsmore Business College and was an Army veteran. 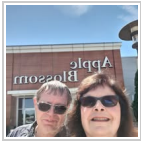
