well as many well-loved years of dirt track competition.

John loved designing "The Reedy Garden." He planted and cared for many unique trees and shrubs in his park which had a self-engineered water wheel with old mill house.

John's passing leaves an immense void in his family's lives, but they find comfort in the knowledge that he is reunited with his mother, sister and numerous loved ones who preceded him. We imagine them waiting on his arrival in heaven. His absence will be deeply felt, and his memory will always be cherished.

John is preceded in death by his mother Rachel C. Sine Reedy, father, Bernie Calvin Reedy, sister Judy Magdic and infant sister Darlene.
