Joseph "Pete" Aldine Orndorff, 75, of Edinburg, passed away at home on Wednesday, March 2, 2022. A memorial service will be held Thursday, March 10, 2022 at 3.00 p.m. at the Edinburg VFW Post #2447. The family will receive friends after the service.

Pete was born September 19, 1946 in Woodstock, VA. He was the son of the late Clarence "Pod" Lee Orndorff and Frances Fern Foltz Orndorff of Edinburg. He was preceded in death by his brother, Clarence "Amos" Douglas Orndorff.

Pete was a 1964 graduate of Central High School. He was an Army veteran, a former highway department employee, truck driver, construction tradesman, and auto detailer. He was a member of Woodstock American Legion Post #199 and Edinburg VFW Post #2447.

He is survived by his two sons; Craig Orndorff of Edinburg and Josh Orndorff of Woodstock; two sisters, Winnie Mitchell of Silver Spring, MD and Sandra Armentrout of Edinburg; brother, Frank Orndorff of Virginia Beach; sister-in-law Sheila Orndorff of Woodstock; and two nieces Elizabeth Orndorff of Woodstock and Natalie Orndorff of Augusta, GA.

In his youth, Pete enjoyed traipsing through the woods and along river and streambanks near the family home. He loved playing Sunday baseball alongside his brothers for the Woodstock Raiders and he passed that passion along to his sons.

Old country and bluegrass music kept him company while keeping an eye on activities along the Fort Road. Funny, witty, and knowledgeable, being with him was always a good time with spirited conversations.
