Kenneth William "Bubby" Dysart, Jr., 76, of Woodstock, passed away March 21, 2024, at Winchester Medical Center, reaching the end of his Earthly journey and finding the peace he earned and desired. Bubby's loss leaves a tremendous void in everyone who knew and loved him, but his memory will remain, ensuring he is never truly forgotten.

Bubby was born April 9, 1947, in Woodstock, the son of Kenneth William "Bill" Dysart, Sr. and Mary Lee Dysart, both of whom preceded him in death. He was also preceded in death by the love of his life, Linda Holler, who passed away in May 2023. Growing up in a large family, Bubby was perhaps the most imposing figure of

them all with a booming voice that could be heard from the next county. However, he was a warm and giving soul with a heart made of gold. Bubby cared deeply for his family and close circle of friends, but he could make complete strangers feel like part of that circle with his kind and welcoming demeanor.

A hard worker his entire life, Bubby spent a large part of his career traveling the country as a dedicated long-haul truck driver. When he retired from the trucking industry, Bubby remained active, spending his time as a cattle farmer and haymaker; activities that brought him great joy and provided a sense of fulfillment.

The family will receive friends Tuesday, March 26 from 6-8 p.m., and a funeral service officiated by Pastor Freddie Helsley, will be held March 27 at 11:00 a.m. both at Valley Funeral Service in Edinburg. Burial will follow at Sunset View Memorial Gardens in Woodstock.
