Kent Robert George, 52, of Edinburg, went to be with his Heavenly Father on August 9, 2011 after a long battle with health problems. The funeral will be Saturday, August 13 at 2:00 p.m. at First Church of Columbia Furnace. Reverend Brian Duncan will officiate. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Kent was born April 15, 1959 in Woodstock son of Alvin and Janet Eastep George of Edinburg. He was a 1977 graduate of Central High School. Kent worked with law enforcement for many years. First as a 911 dispatcher for Shenandoah County, and then as a surveillance officer for probation and parole in Rockingham County.
