Leona Wakeman Dirting, 97, of Edinburg, passed away Wednesday, January 12, 2022, at home. A funeral service will be held Wednesday, January 19, at 2:00 pm at Wakemans Grove Church of the Brethren. Ms. Dirting was born a farmer, an occupation and lifestyle she lived and practiced her entire life. On June 25, 1949, she married Paul William Dirting, and they began farming together raising cattle, crops, and two children, four grandchildren, and ten great grandchildren. After Paul's passing in November of 2000, Leona continued to lead and support the family and farm with continued examples of her faith and hard work.
