Linda Sue Walters, 72, of Fort Valley, Virginia, passed away peacefully at home on August 17, 2024. Born on May 15, 1952, in Frederick, Maryland, Linda was a cherished wife, mother, grandmother, sister, and friend.

Linda is survived by her devoted husband, Ernest Carroll Walters; her sons, Larry Walters (Shannon) and Adam Walters; and her beloved grandchildren, Gage Walters and Peter Walters. She also leaves behind her favorite brother, Gary Lee Pritchett (Jo Anne), and his daughters, Whitney Willet (Jesse, Eli, and Zeke) and Jill Roth (Scott). Linda graduated from high school and pursued nursing studies in Baltimore, MD. Her life's work was deeply intertwined with her love for music and community service. As the pianist and organist at Faith Lutheran Church for 52 years, Linda's music was a cornerstone of the church's worship and community life. She played a vital role in the church as a secretary, treasurer of the Ladies Aid, chairman of the Call Committee, and member of the Worship and Music Committee. She was also a founding member of the Faith Lutheran Preschool auction and dedicated her time to teaching CPR and First Aid for over 20 years.

Her career also included significant contributions to Caroline Lutheran Camp,

where she trained everyone from executive directors to camp staff. Linda retired from Emanuel Lutheran Church in December 2020, leaving behind a legacy of dedication and service.

Linda was a vibrant presence in her community, a founding member of the Fort Valley Substation to Woodstock Rescue Squad, where she was honored as a life member. Her love for hymns, music of all kinds, and her cherished family was evident in everything she did. She enjoyed chocolate, adored her grandchildren and grand-dogs, and was an enthusiastic supporter of her church and community.

A memorial service celebrating Linda's life will be held on Wednesday, August 21, 2024, at 11:00am at Faith Lutheran Church in Fort Valley, Virginia. Pastor Nathan Robinson will officiate. The family will receive friends on Tuesday from 6-8pm at the church.
