Louise Elaine Lambert Garman, 97, of Woodstock, VA passed away Friday, March 8, 2024 at her home of natural causes. The funeral service will be held, Friday, March 15 at 11:00 a.m. at the Woodstock Presbyterian Church, 142 E. Court Street. Reverend Brittney Lane will officiate.

Mrs. Garman was born Nov. 9, 1926 in Edinburg, the oldest of five children to the late Bennie Eli and Sada Kathryn Coffman Lambert. She was preceded in death by her sisters, Evelyn Neff, Eunice Taylor, Emma Belle Cooley and brother, Joseph B. Lambert. She was a 1944 graduate of Woodstock High School and worked on the family farm and with her father at Lamberts Meat Market. In 1947 she went to work at Ben Franklin Store on Main Street in Woodstock. Along with loving her job, Louise would come to find the love of her life in Donald H. Garman whom she married on October 12, 1947. They

would continue building a beautiful family business with Ben Franklin Stores until Don's death on Jan. 1, 1989. Louise continued the family business known as Ben's Diner until her death.

Louise was the oldest living member of the Woodstock Presbyterian Church where she served as an elder, communion hostess, sang in the church choir and was instrumental in the Women of the Church. As a charter member and Past President of Muhlenberg Unit 199 American Legion Auxiliary, Louise served her community in support of American veterans. Louise was initiated in Woodstock Chapter 93 Order of the Eastern Star on September 11, 1952. She served as a Worthy Matron several times and was Chapter organist. Louise was a member of Woodstock Rescue Squad Auxiliary and served as State President.

Louise is survived by her four children, Constance Louise, Donald Herbert Jr. (Dianne), William John (Susan), and Kenneth Lemoyne (Mikki); ten grandchildren, Stephen Brent, Patricia Louise, Eric Lemoyne (Shalyn), Heather Bess, Brad Allen, Jonathon Nicholas, Susan Elizabeth, Jessica Lynn, Shawn Michael (Julie) and Katelyn Marie (Kyle); 15 great grandchildren; two great great grandchildren; and 11 nieces and nephews.
