



## Luther G. Norris Jr.

October 18, 1930 - September 6, 2021

Luther G. Norris, Jr. of Fairview died Monday, September 6th at Greenfield Reflections of Woodstock. He was born October 18, 1930, in Quantico, Virginia, to the late Luther G. and Ruth Salisbury Norris. He is survived by his wife, Linda Jo Norris of Maurertown; a daughter, Cynthia Ann Phillips and husband, Billy, of Mt. Pleasant, North Carolina; four grandchildren, Joshua and Wesley Phillips, Rhiannon Bernardin, and Christopher Warren; four great grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his sister Ann Gurney, brother Don Norris, a son, Luther G. Norris, III and daughter-in-law Mary Ann, of Katy, Texas, and daughter Tamera Ellen McCurry. As the son of a military officer, the Norris family lived more than five years in Cuba, where the family met and spent time with Ernest Hemingway. Mr. Norris was a graduate of N.E. Louisiana State and was employed as an electrical engineer, serving at various times at Camp LeJeune and Cherry Point, North Carolina, TENECO, Daniel Orfice Fitting Company, and at Perforating Guns Atlas Corporation. Luther was a charter member of the Society of American Military Engineers at Camp LeJeune. He retired after thirty years of federal service with the Department of Defense. He served in the Air Force from 1950 -1954 during the Korean conflict. Luther was a charter member of the LeJeune Flying Club. He held a private pilot's license and enjoyed flying Cessna 150's. In later years he built and flew radio-control model airplanes and was a member of the Rockingham Area Flyers. He was a member of the Strasburg Seventh Day Adventist Church. The funeral will be

conducted at 11:00 A.M. on Thursday, September 9, 2021, at Dellinger Funeral Home in Woodstock by the Rev. Anna Havron. Burial will be in Sunset View Memorial Gardens, Woodstock.
