Marcia Lynn Jonas Holtzman, a resident of Mount Sidney, died Thursday June 1st, 2017.

She was born on November 5, 1944, in Roanoke, Virginia, and was the only daughter of the late Lilburn L. Jonas and Florence Rieley Jonas.

She was an Alumnus of Bridgewater College and Shenandoah College and Conservatory of Music.

She was the owner of Heatherfield Properties.

She was the former Choral Director of Central High School and former Director of Volunteer Services at Shenandoah County Memorial Hospital.

She was a member of the Board of Directors of the Shenandoah County Bicentennial Commission, former officer of the Virginia State Horticultural Society Women's Auxiliary, founder and former Chairman of the Holiday Bazaar for Shenandoah County Memorial Hospital Auxiliary and recipient of the Outstanding Community Service Award presented by the Woodstock Chamber of Commerce. She was former General Chairman of the Shenandoah County Civic Center and Armory Foundation, former Member of the Patrons Circle of the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, former Member of Board of Directors of Belle Grove Plantation, former Member of Board of Directors of Wayside Theatre, former Director of Miss Shenandoah County Fair Pageant, former Member of the Board of Directors of Shenandoah County Chapter of the American Red Cross, former Member of Parent Advisory Board for Shenandoah County Public Schools, and Central

High School Parent Advisory Committee, former Secretary of Shenandoah County Scholarship Foundation and formerly appointed by Shenandoah County Board of Supervisors to Board of Directors of Northwestern Community Services. She had the title of Miss Shenandoah Valley in 1964, and was a former member of the Edinburg Community Singers.

She is survived by a daughter, Jill Holtzman Vogel and husband, Alex, of Upperville; a son, Todd Holtzman, and wife, Lynn, of Mount Jackson; one brother, L. Leroy Jonas, Jr. of Annapolis, Maryland; and seven grandchildren, William Vogel, John "Jack" Vogel, Thomas "Tas" Vogel and Olivia Vogel of Upperville, and Henry Holtzman, Oliver Holtzman and Elliott Holtzman of Mount Jackson.

The Funeral Service will be held Saturday, June 10, 2017, at 11:00 am at Blue Ridge Church of the Brethren, 5484 Blue Ridge Boulevard, Blue Ridge, Virginia and Interment will be at Sherwood Memorial Park in Salem.
