Marie Estell "Cookie" Foltz, 82, of Woodstock passed away Monday, May 5, 2025, in Woodstock. “ To know Cookie is to know a remarkable human being. I was with Cookie for the one year I spent in Greenfield Senior Living. During that time, I witnessed Cookie’s acts of kindness, sharing of wisdom and instinct for doing the right thing under adverse circumstances. One such example was when a serious fire broke out in the early morning hours. Staffing was always minimal during the night shift, but they were desperately getting all the clients out as fast as they could, while firemen rushed in through the haze with their equipment. With all the commotion to save lives, patients were taken out in the 15 degree morning with whatever they had on. Many were screaming, “I’m cold!” “I need a blanket!” “Help me!” I stood beside Cookie who was clothed only in a thin nightgown and a small blanket thrown over her knees. Her left side had been paralyzed from a stroke that created minimum circulation in her arm and leg and was always cold. Mr Hepner was in a wheelchair beside us and was so thin, the frigid air was turning his body blue, but he didn’t complain. Cookie looked up at me and extended the blanket off her knees to me and said, “Here, cover Mr Hepner with this.” She did this knowing the cold could severely impact her health and shivered herself after losing the blanket. Cookie exemplified the kind of person I wanted to become. She showed all of us the way to a better, kinder world.
