



## Marion "Lucy" Wright Clark

June 29, 1932 - November 3, 2024

The staff of Heishman Funeral Home/Valley Funeral Service sends condolences to the family of Marion "Lucy" Wright Clark.

Marion "Lucy" Wright Clark, of Woodstock, Virginia, died Sunday, November 3rd, at the age of 92. She had suffered a stroke. Mrs. Clark was an internationally recognized maker of hand-hooked rugs. In 1996, one of her rugs was selected by a jury to appear among nineteen original designs from the United States and Canada in the "Celebration" issue of Rug Hooking magazine. The following year, this piece was awarded first place in original designs in the readers' choice portion of the competition.

Mrs. Clark was born Marion Lucille Wright on June 29, 1932 in her parents' home in Staunton, Virginia. She was the daughter of Lenva Cecil "L.C. or Len" Wright and the former Antha Mae Stogdale.

Mrs. Clark attended Beverly Manor and Wilson High Schools. She met her husband George V. Clark at Bridgewater College where she was an English major. The couple graduated in 1953 and married in 1954. The following year, they moved to Fairfax where George worked for the health department and State Farm Insurance. She taught school in Aldie and Centreville until the birth of her first child, Ann Marie. Children Emily and George followed.

The Clarks were dedicated members of Oakton Church of the Brethren, with Mrs. Clark serving in various capacities including deacon and moderator. Upon moving to Woodstock in the 1990s, the couple joined the Woodstock Presbyterian Church.

Mrs. Clark's husband died in 2003. She was also predeceased by her parents and her siblings, Antha Bright and Ray Walton Wright, Sr.

Mrs. Clark is survived by children Ann Marie Clark (James McCann) of West Lafayette, Indiana; Emily Sue Clark (Bradley McLemore) of Portland, Oregon; and George Edward Clark (Elizabeth) and grandchildren Will and Sophie of Stow, MA. She also leaves many friends, loved ones, and extended family members.

With the support of friends, family, and visiting caregivers, Lucy Clark was living on her own up until her final days.

Visitation will be held this Friday night, November 8th, from six to eight p.m. at Valley Funeral Service in Edinburg. The funeral will be at Woodstock Presbyterian Church at 5 p.m. Saturday with reception to follow in the fellowship hall.

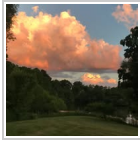
