January 4, 1923 - June 29, 2022

Ora Lee (Hotinger) Hepner, a resident of Greenfield of Woodstock, passed away on June 29, 2022, at the age of 99. She was born in Collierstown, Virginia to Ray W. Hotinger and Ora Montgomery Hotinger on January 4, 1923. Mrs. Hepner is survived by four children, Sandra Lee Mann (William), Larry Link Hepner (Cheryl), Donna Lynne Hepner (Stephen Von Wald) and Michael Leonard Hepner (Shannon); eight grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren. After a teaching career of 29 years, Mrs. Hepner retired to the Shenandoah Valley with her husband, where she pursued her many interests, including bowling, bridge and investing in the stock market.
