Ruby Dellinger Hawkins, 92, of Edinburg, passed away Thursday, February 18 2016 at Greenfield Senior Living in Woodstock. She was a dedicated and faithful member of Christ U.C.C. in Conicville and served on the consistory, served several years as secretary and was a Sunday School teacher. She was a charter member of the Church Women's Guild and served in different offices and was treasurer for 54 years. She was a member of the 4-H, Edinburg VFW and Conicville Home Demonstration Club. She worked at American Viscose Plant in Front Royal, Woodstock Coat Manufacturing, Bowman Apple Products for 20 years and retired from Woodstock Aileen Inc. after 22 years in 1995. She was preceded in death by her husband, Robert D. Hawkins Sr. who passed away on June 8, 1973 at the age of 48; sister, Goldie Tisinger and three brothers Marvin T. Dellinger, Clyde E. Dellinger and Marshall Dellinger who was killed in World War II. Ruby is survived by her sons and daughter, Robert D.
