



## Scott Alexander Cunius

January 20, 1964 - May 27, 2021

Scott Alexander Cunius died from Covid-19 on May 27, 2021, in Winchester, VA. A joint service will be held with his mom, who died the same week of Covid-19, at Mt. Hermon United Methodist Church in Mt. Jackson, VA, on July 10, 2021, at 1 p.m. Scott was born on January 20, 1964, in Fairfax, VA, the son of William and Carol Cunius, who both worked for the CIA. He was a 1982 graduate of James Madison High School in Vienna, VA, where he excelled on both the football and tennis teams. Later, he was a ski instructor at Bryce Mountain for many years, and enjoyed summers at Silver Lake, NY. Scott worked for the CIA 1980s and 1990s and was a natural born salesman who had the gift of gab. He managed several cigar stores over the years.
