Seth Ryan Bauserman, 29, of Edinburg, crossed into his eternal life on Saturday, June 25, 2022. Seth was a three-sport athlete at Central High School, chosen as team captain in football and basketball, and received Central's Male Athlete of the Year in 2011. He furthered his education by attending James Madison

University and receiving his Bachelor of Arts degree in History (2017), and his Master of Education in Teaching degree in Secondary Education (2018). Seth became employed by the Shenandoah County School System in 2018 and returned to his alma mater as a History and Government teacher. His love for Central High School sports led him to his role as assistant coach in varsity football and baseball, and head coach of junior varsity football and baseball, leading his baseball team to the district JV championship in 2019. Seth was an advocate and mentor to his students sharing his quiet presence and genuine concern for their lives within and outside the classroom. He loved well and was well loved by his “Blue and Gold” family and community.

Seth was the proud co-owner and operator of K.A.S.H. Farms in Edinburg. His passion for farming was evident when driving his tractor, caring for his livestock, or sharing “farm talk”. Seth’s love for agriculture and diligent work ethic employed him at Farmer’s Livestock Exchange Inc in Winchester and Baker’s Farm Fresh Pork.

Seth was a baptized and confirmed member of Mt. Zion Lutheran Church in Woodstock, where he established life-long friendships and lasting memories with his church family.
