



## Shirley Dellinger Leake

Shirley Dellinger Leake, 94, of Woodstock passed away March 24, 2022 at RMH. A Memorial Service will be at 1:00 PM on Saturday, April 2, 2022, at Christ Church United Church of Christ, Conicville. In 1946, Shirley graduated from the Pauline's School of Cosmetology in Harrisonburg. For 6 years, she operated a salon in Edinburg and later in her home for many years. Shirley also worked for Bowman's Applesauce Plant in Mt. Jackson, Windsor Knit in Edinburg, and then retired from Aileen after 28 years. She was a Women's Auxiliary member of the Edinburg VFW Post #2447, The Woodstock American Legion Post #199, and a Lifetime member of the Women's Guild at Christ Church United Church of Christ, Conicville. She was preceded in death by her husband Everette William Leake and Shirley is the last surviving member of her family.
