



## Terry Lee Kibler

June 28, 1958 - November 26, 2018

Terry Lee Kibler, 60, of Woodstock, passed away Monday, November 26, 2018, at his home. The family will receive friends Friday, November 30, 2018, from 6 to 8 p.m. with a Masonic service beginning at 7:45 p.m. at Valley Funeral Service near Edinburg. A graveside service will be held Saturday, December 1, 2018, at 2:00 p.m. at Massanutten Cemetery in Woodstock. Pastor Elfie Finn-McKenzie will officiate. After the graveside service, a meal will follow at the Fairgrounds. All friends are welcome. If you would like, bring a covered dish.

Terry was born June 28, 1958, in Winchester, the son of the late Earl Lee Kibler and Mabel Hoover Kibler. Terry was a 1976 graduate of Central High School and graduated from Virginia Tech in 1980 with a degree in Animal Science. He was the owner of Kibler's Furniture in Woodstock for more than 30 years and ran a successful harness racing business. Terry was a member of the Masonic Lodge and the Odd Fellows, past President and current board member of the Shenandoah County Fair Association, and Secretary of Harness Racing at the Fair.

Terry is survived by his sister, Rhonda Kibler Hetzel and husband Adrian of Clarkston, Michigan; three nieces, Lauren Zollinger and husband Stefan of Rockford, Michigan, Kristen Hetzel and Kaitlin Hetzel both of Clarkston, Michigan, and great-nephew, Garrett Lee Zollinger.
