



## Victor Orman Marcellus

Victor ""Vic"" Orman Marcellus, 91, of Strasburg passed away on Friday, August 11, 2023. Mr. Marcellus was born on March 20, 1932, in Hatboro, Pennsylvania and was the son of the late Virgil ""Slim"" and Lois Kirkpatrick Marcellus. He was a 1950 graduate of Glassboro High School in New Jersey and a US Army combat veteran, serving during the Korean Conflict. He was employed for many years at the Shenandoah Publishing House in Strasburg, where he served as a board member and production manager, and at Atlantic Research in Alexandria. After retirement he became self-employed in Consumer Direct Marketing. He was a member of the Woodstock American Legion Post #199 and a lifetime member of Fagowee (Lost Tribe) Ski Club.
