Dr. Wallace Bradshaw Lutz, 78, of Woodstock, passed away Friday, February 2, 2018 at Shenandoah Memorial Hospital in Woodstock. A Celebration of Life will be held Wednesday, February 7 at 7:00 p.m. at Valley Pike Church of the Brethren. Pastor Jonathan Fletcher will officiate.

Dr. Lutz was born November 8, 1939 in Conicville, VA son of the late Roy Isaac Lutz and Cornelia Carroll Lutz. He graduated from Harrisonburg High School, Bridgewater College and the Medical College of Virginia. He was a dentist having his own business in Shenandoah County for over 53 years.
