Warren Lynn Eisert was born in Scottsbluff, Nebraska on March 14, 1949. He died July 2, 2023, at his home after a long battle with cancer. A memorial service will be held Saturday, July 22 at 10:00am at The Church of Jesus Christ Of Latter-Day Saints. Inurnment will be held Monday, July 24 at 11:00am at Culpeper National Cemetery.

Warren is predeceased by his father, Werner August Eisert, an immigrant from Berlin, Germany, and his mother, Eunice Cannon Eisert Stevens. He is survived by his wife of 44 years, Marilyn Felts Eisert, his daughter, Amy Luther (Lloyd), and two grandchildren. He is also survived by his sisters, Sheryll Seymour of Gilbert, Arizona, and Jerri Chamberlain (Dennis) of Woodland, California, and his brother Marvin Eisert of Hanford, California.

Warren grew up and attended schools in Nebraska where he loved the outdoors and animals, especially dogs. His love of nature and animals continued throughout his life.

After high school, Warren joined the Army Corp of Engineers where he worked on military vehicles. He served in Vietnam, and was also stationed in

Germany, Alaska, Maryland, Germany (again), and Georgia.

While stationed at Fort Meade, Maryland, Warren met his future wife, Marilyn Felts. Marilyn was serving in the Women's Army Corp. They met at church. Marilyn saw Warren and thought, "That's my guy". They were eventually married on December 15, 1978, in the Washington D.C. Temple of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints.

After the military, Warren worked for the Government for Navy Federal in Washington D.C. First as a Federal Guard, then retired as a Federal Police Officer.

He and Marilyn made their home in Edinburg, Virginia.
