William Newland Paxton, 99, of Mt. Jackson, died Saturday, December 4, 2010 at V. A. Medical Center in Martinsburg, WVA. Mr. Paxton was born February 18, 1911 in Covington, son of the late Thomas R. and Margaret Newland Paxton. He was a 1930 graduate of Triplett High School in Mt. Jackson. He served in the United States Army during W.W. II in the 101 st. Airborne Division, 327 th Glider Regiment. He received two Bronze Stars and a Purple Heart. He was a member of Oak Hill Lodge No 120, Scottish Rite of Free Masonry, Beni Kedem Temple, American Legion Post 0106, and Disabled American Veterans. He was a member of St. Andrew's Episcopal Church in Mt. Jackson. Mr. Paxton is survived by cousins, Gordon D. Bowman II of Mt. Jackson, Peggy B. Zirkle of College Park, MD, Rodney Paxton of Staunton and a lifelong friend, Julia Fansler. Also surviving are faithful caregivers, Nelson and Mary Sager, Georgie Fahrney, Shirley Patton and Susan Vasquez. He was preceded in death November 6, 2001 by a sister, Kathryn Streetman. Committal services will be Thursday at 1 p.m. at the Mt. Jackson Cemetery by Father Alexander MacPhail.
